**1. ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The DMCC INC, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the C&R Construction 2018 Kamfari 'KAMFARI' for Senior Bikes and Quads on the 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018

**2. JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Australia Northern Territory (MANT) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number 1/18/C/100XX and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior Motorcycling Australia Licences or One Event Licences.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by MANT.

**BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

**3. ENTRIES:**

- 3.1 Entries open forthwith and close 8pm Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2018.
- 3.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Promoter, if such retention is approved by MANT.
- 3.3 As a parent of a person under the age of 18 years, the under 18 yr old must be "signed in" by the Parent/Guardian, or you must fill in the DEED OF APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY GUARDIAN form for the under 18yr old to appoint a Person to "sign my minor in" at a race meeting. NOTE: The appointed person must be 18 or over in age and the deed of appointment form is available from the Race Secretary
- 3.4 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.5 **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED UP TO 8.00AM SUNDAY 6<sup>TH</sup> MAY. THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.**
- 3.6 If emailing entry passes can be collected at the nominations desk/scrutineering on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2018 at NT Powersports, Coolalinga.

- 3.7 All riders get a free T shirt and stubbie cooler. Finishers get a Kamfari memento.  
3.8 Your entry fee gets you in the race in the outright placings. You will be given a sponsor sticker that will be adhered to by the scrutineer and must remain on bike/quad for the duration of the event.

#### 4. **INSURANCE:**

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.  
4.2. Ambulance subscription / membership is compulsory for full MA race licencees.

#### 4.3 **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

#### 5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

SENIOR FIRST AID VOLUNTEERS WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE. RIDERS ARE REQUESTED TO HAVE AMBULANCE COVER

#### 6 **ENTRY FEE:**

- 6.1. ENTRY FEE \$160.00 UP TO 8PM Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2018.  
LATE ENTRY FEE \$220.00 AFTER 8PM FRIDAY 5<sup>th</sup> May 2018 TO 8:00AM SUNDAY 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018.  
Extra classes: (Veterans and Rookie) is no extra cost (see entry form)  
**You must tick the box(s) for what extra class**
- 6.2. Payment by Cash, business cheque, direct deposit, money order or EFTPOS. **Direct deposit to bank account will be accepted up to COB THURSDAY 3<sup>rd</sup> MAY 2018. No personal cheques accepted. - 6.3. Business Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the DMCC Inc.

#### 7 **CLASSES OF COMPETITION**

- 7.1 **TRACK 1 BIKES** **CLASSES:** Bike entry  
Veterans 40 years and up  
Rookie Class (First Time in Kamfari, non pro rider)
- 7.2 **TRACK 2 QUADS** **CLASSES:** (1) Quad Entry (Min 710cc to max 930cc and 30" tyres)  
(2) Quad Entry (Max 700cc and 30" tyres)  
Veterans 40 years and up  
Rookie Class (First Time in Kamfari, non pro rider)

#### 8 **AWARDS AND PRIZE MONEY:**

Prize money (bike and quad the same) Outright Placing's Only:

1 <sup>st</sup> Place	\$2,000.00
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	\$1,000.00
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	\$500.00

Trophies (bike and quad the same):

Outright 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>

Veterans 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>

Rookies 1<sup>st</sup>

Quad classes (1) and (2) 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>

All finishers receive a memento

#### 9 **ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**

- 9.1 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 5 (five).  
9.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prize money, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to MANT approval.

#### 10. **MACHINES AND RIDERS:**

- 10.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Enduro competition.  
10.2. Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.  
10.3 All bikes must be big wheel and minimum of 125cc 2 stroke or 200cc 4 stroke. All quads must be 200cc and over to a maximum 930cc and 30" tyres. No postie or road bikes allowed.  
10.4 All riders must be 16 years old and over

#### 11. **RIDING NUMBERS:**

- 11.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number, preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Promoter's discretion. Please enquire before scrutineering  
11.2. All number plates on all quads MUST comply with the GCR's.  
11.3 All riders must make their number known when passing checkpoints. Yell it out !

#### 12 **RIDERS' BRIEFING:**

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors **MUST** attend. Details will be included in the final instructions.

### **13 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:**

- 13.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA Drug Education Program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission Policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 13.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at the MANT discretion until the results of the tests are known.  
For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be at commencement of the Riders Briefing and ending with the completion of the race for the participant.

### **14 CODE OF CONDUCT:**

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

### **15 TIMETABLE:**

#### **15.1 NOMINATION DESK / SCRUTINEERING TIME: 6.00pm to 8.00pm Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2018 at NT Powersports, Coolalinga NT including scrutineering.**

**All riders must sign-on at the track 7.30 to 8.00am Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018**

- 15.2 Late nominations available to 8.00am Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018 at race track start area. Last minute scrutineering may be available for Bikes/Quads at race track start area until 8.00am.
- 15.3 RIDER BRIEFING 9.15am Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018
- 15.4 BIKE RACING START TIME 10.00am Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018
- 15.5 QUAD RACING TIME up to 15 mins after bikes on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018
- 15.6 FINISH WILL BE WHEN THE RIDER IN FULL RACING GEAR IN FIRST PLACE CROSSES THE LINE AFTER 4 HOURS

### **16 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:**

Approx. 13 km Track Marked with Pink Tape for bikes and blue for quads

### **17 STARTS:**

DEAD ENGINE SHOT GUN START STANDING REAR OF BIKE/QUAD. Starter: Dennis Saunders

### **18 RACING:**

4 HOURS unless clerk of course / steward decides otherwise. Competitors will need to complete at least two laps and pass the chequered flag to be classified as a finisher.

### **19 GST:**

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$75.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

### **20 PIT AREA:** Disciplinary action will be at the discretion of the clerk of course.

- 20.1 No Alcoholic beverages allowed in pit area in accordance with the GCR's
- 20.2 No smoking in pit area
- 20.3 No person may wear open footwear in the pit area in accordance with the GCR's with each rider only having 1 nominated pit person.
- 20.4 Crew (one pit person only) must not be in pit area when your rider is in the pit area (must have ID). If sharing tent all pit persons for those crew must be outside the pit area when any of the riders are in.
- 20.5 No tools or spare parts in pits **or** within 5 metres of pit fence. You may have a small table and chair in your pit area if you desire. Your area is no more than 3M x 3M. You may share with another rider if you desire.
- 20.6 No outside assistance apart from other competitors and officials.
- 20.7 No family or friends in pits, only your nominated pit person may enter here.
- 20.8 Enviro mat must be used under machine when re-fuelling and stationary
- 20.9 Fast fuelers and stands are allowed. Bucket with water and rag OK as well as oils and dispersants. Fan OK, Generator must be outside the inner fence line.
- 20.10 Brand names and business names are allowed on the standard 3M x 3M Quick shades.

### **21 QUAD RESTRICTIONS**

- 21.1 All quads are restricted to a maximum of 30" tyres that are available from an Australian Dealer. Tractor style or knuckle tread tyres are allowed but no paddle tyres or tyres with side paddles are allowed
- 21.2 Winches are allowed
- 21.3 Kill switch and lanyard must be fitted
- 21.4 Nurf bars fitted
- 21.5 Number plates front and rear and on back of rider
- 21.6 930cc Max engine size for 4 strokes and 550cc for 2 strokes. All must be max 2 cylinders
- 21.7 Enviro mat must be used under machine when re-fuelling and stationary

## 22 SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 22.1 Competitors still in event may assist other riders and **must be still circulating** on the course. Outside assistance is forbidden. Marshal / Official may assist. No 'ghost' riders (riders entered into the event with the express purpose of helping just friends or team members) are allowed. If anyone is caught doing this that rider and the rider that is being helped will be disqualified from the event. In fact, the whole team will be removed from racing.
- 22.2 No pit crew in pits when you are in there. 1 person pit crew only. Remember....you are responsible for your pit person. He / she can get you disqualified by not following the rules! Pit person may refill your fuel container or fast fill, wash your spare goggles and refresh your water while you are not there. When you arrive in the pits your pit person must not be there. Pit person must have his / her Pit Crew ID on. Pit person, friends and any gear or vehicles must be at least **5 metres** away from the inner pit perimeter fence. You may have a quick shade on the inner pit fence.
- 22.3 Course cutting will result in immediate disqualification. You may go away from single pink tapes as long as they are within easy sight (for example, going wide on a bog hole). This does not apply if you are travelling down an adjacent road or track or cutting a portion of the course out. Use your common sense. If you are way off the track you will get disqualified. If there is any continuous taping or bunting, you must stay within the confines of this.
- 22.4 Anyone in the race found with their bike or quad to be outside of the rules as listed in these supplementary regulations, as a result of either deceit or modification after scrutineering, the rider will be immediately disqualified from the event, entry fees non-refundable, and possibly banned from any future DMCC events, at the discretion of the executive committee.
- 22.5 **TEAR OFFS ARE NOT ALLOWED.** You may keep spare goggles in your pits. Roll offs OK.
- 22.6 Enviro mats **MUST** be used in the pits. Your machine must be parked on this when re-fuelling, engine off.
- 22.7 Code of Conduct will apply GCR'S S including the actions of agents and parents
- 22.8 No Animals allowed as per GCR'S
- 22.9 **TRACK WILL BE CLOSED FOR ALL COMPETITORS, RIDING OR WALKING PRIOR TO THE EVENT.**  
**Kamfari committee would like to back to the roots of the event and enforce NO RIDERS TO WALK, RIDE OR INSPECT THE TRACK (INCLUDING VIA DRONES) PRIOR TO THE MEETING.**
- 22.10 NOTE: Double points will be awarded for DMCC's Mr.ENDURO and Club Champion only if you are a full financial DMCC member as of 9<sup>TH</sup> April 2018 (cut off date for membership renewal)
- 22.11 Tents and structures bigger than the normal 3MX3M Quickshades are not allowed. Any advertising or banners and the like must be approved by DMCC President or Secretary **before** race day.
- 22.12 Please make sure you are entered in the right classes.

# KAMFARI RULES YOU MUST KNOW

**SINGLE TAPE TRACK MARKERS MUST BE IN RIDERS SIGHT AT ALL TIMES - RIDERS TO STAY INSIDE CONTINUOUS TAPE/BUNTING CHANNELS**

**REFUEL WITH ENGINE OFF AND WITH ENVIRO MAT UNDER STATIONARY MACHINE**

**NO ALCOHOL IN THE PITS**

**CLOSED FOOTWEAR IN THE PITS**

**1 X PIT CREW IN THE PITS – MUST NOT BE IN THE PITS WHEN HIS RIDER IS IN THE PITS - IF SHARING TENT ALL PIT PERSONS FOR THOSE CREW MUST BE OUTSIDE THE PIT AREA WHEN ANY OF THE RIDERS ARE IN**

**NO TOOLS OR SPARES IN THE PITS - ALL TOOLS AND SPARES TO BE CARRIED ON BIKE OR BODY**

**NO OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE- MARSHALS AND OTHER ACTIVE COMPETITORS MAY ASSIST**

**COURSE CUTTING WILL LEAD TO IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION**

**RIDERS MUST SLOW AND CALL OUT NUMBER AT CHECKPOINTS – LOOK FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FROM SCORERS**

**NO TEAR OFFS ALLOWED**

**NO RIDERS TO WALK, RIDE OR INSPECT THE TRACK (INCLUDING VIA DRONES) PRIOR TO THE MEETING.**
