RIDERS TO WATCH

ROBBIE KOLLMAN - After seeing his brilliant win in the recent UNIPART OFF ROAD 200 no one can question his style. He won the 77 Kamfari and placed 2nd on three previous occasions.

Last year he was forced out of the Great Northern 200 by machine failure.

This year on his Yamaha IT 400F with the sponsorship of Enduro Motorcycles, he will be in the battle to take out the open class and overall event.



HANS VAN SANTEN - Hans is one of Darwin's more versatile motorcycle enthusiasts having at one time or another, ridden many types of motorcycles in all kinds of events and is a keen supporter of the clubs.

Winner of such races as the RODNEY DAVIS MEMORIAL in Alice Springs; the Radio 8HA 12 Hour DESERT RACE also in the Alice and the YAMAHA N.T. NEWS SUPERCROSS held in Darwin, just to name a few.

Hans always finishes high in the placings, and has more than a good chance of winning his class and is another propable for winning overall.

CLINT HOLMES - Sponsored by Enduro Motorcycles, Clint has an impressive record in enduro events. Last year riding for Castrol, Clint took the MR. ENDURO Title after winning four of the five enduros he rode in. This year he has won the Scotts Creek Enduro.

On his YAMAHA IT400F has a good chance of placing near or at the top of the event.



BRIAN BADER - A very fast rider, Brian is one of the big boys doing battle for the title. Overall winner of the 79 ANABUR 2 DAY ENDURO he also placed well in the 77 Kamfari and Great Northern 200. A recent 2nd place in the UNIPART shows he's on form for this event.

REGULATIONS

The race will be an open competition for motorcycles. The organisers reserve the right to reject any entry.

Classification of bikes will be determined by Machine Examiner, with a minimum bike size of 100cc.

The course will be approximately 160km total distance.

No practise will be allowed on the course. The course will be marked with tapes.

The start will be a dead motor Le Mans, Gun start. Start assistance allowed 2nd gun, 15 seconds.

Machine, helmet and clothing examination starts at 8.00a.m.

START 10AM

All bikes must be presented to Machine Examiner completely prepared to race. Once bike examined, positions to be taken up on start line and no further mechanical preparation or maintenance to be done on machine until after start of race.

The finish flag will be displayed when the first rider has completed 160km. Race declared after first three riders have completed course and other places will be counted back from then.

All tools and spares shall be carried on machine, plus emergency fuel, 1 litre is necessary. Other fuel and oil (including chain lube) shall be left in pit area. No other tools will be allowed in the pit area and only tools and parts carried on machine can be used. Anyone found breaking these regulations will be disqualified. Engines shall be stopped for refuelling. Assistance will only be allowed in the pit area, i.e., holding machine while rider refuels or repairs and washing of numbers, by other competitive riders or marshalls or race officials. Riders shall do their own work.

Minimum protective apparell- strong, calf length boots; padded, denim jeans; approved helmet and long sleeved, approved riding jersey to be worn. Goggles and gloves optional.

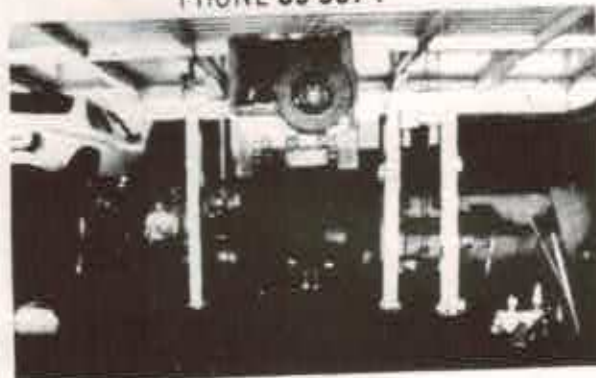

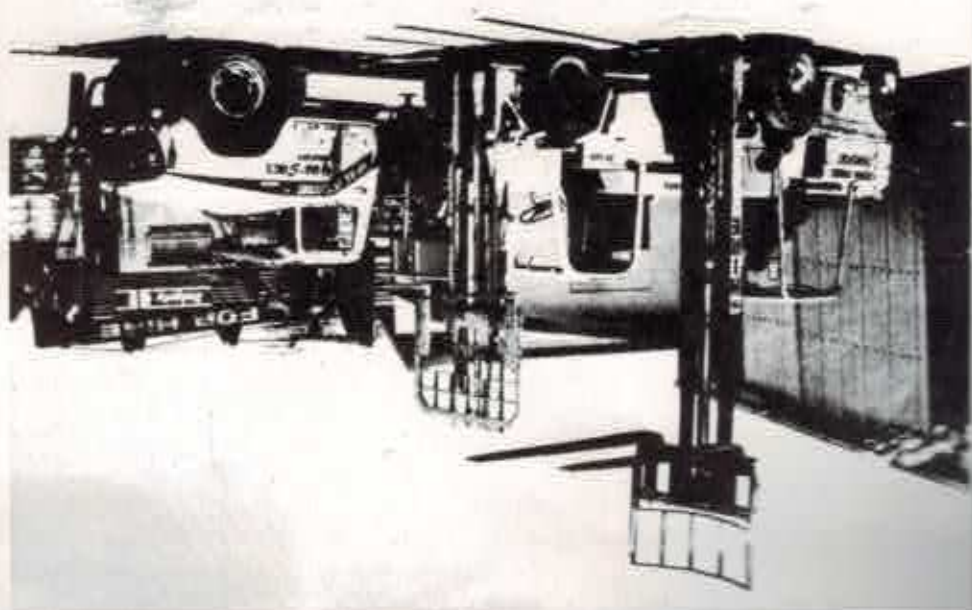
